

PORCH LIGHT PROGRAM INSTALLATION AGREEMENT



The Porch Light Program is a City-led program, in partnership with the Grand Haven Board of Light and Power (GHBLP), to deliver 2,500 LED light bulbs to Grand Haven residents. The GHBLP donated the LED light bulbs to the City as part of the Energy Waste Reduction Program, which requires electric utilities to create customer programs to improve energy efficiency.

The LED light bulbs are free to pick up for eligible individuals in Grand Haven City Hall at 519 Washington Ave, Grand Haven, MI 49417. Residents can also receive the bulbs from a City staff member at their home or during a community event.

I, _____, understand and agree to the following statements:

- 1) Bulb recipients must be GHBLP customers who live in the municipality of Grand Haven.
- 2) Bulb recipients must give their name, phone number, and address for reporting purposes.
- 3) LED light bulbs may only be used on one's residential property to replace porch lights.
- 4) Bulb recipients must install the bulbs in the porch of their home by December 31, 2020.
- 5) Bulb recipients will assume responsibility for their bulb upon receiving one.
- 6) The City of Grand Haven is not responsible for any damage to property that may occur during the bulb installation process.
