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GRAND HAVEN LAUNCHES SEECLICKFIX® APPLICATION

GRAND HAVEN, Mich. (June 20, 2016) – The City of Grand Haven is set to launch See Click Fix to its more than 10,000 residents. Citizens are now able to report non-emergency issues directly to the city through a web-based application. City Council and staff view this application as an additional method to gain public participation and effectively address critical concerns.

Citizens can download the SeeClickFix application to their mobile devices, or use a desktop computer to transmit their reports of damaged street signs, sidewalks, potholes, fallen tree limbs, traffic light outages, and more.
